

myPass Credential Print Out with Parent Signature

Step 1 – Sign in using your Education Account (not school email)

myPass is an Alberta Education self-service website for students to:

- Order high school transcripts in English and French
- √ View diploma exam marks
- Register to write or rewrite diploma exams with online payment
- View and print Detailed Academic Reports (DAR)
- View progress towards a credential (diploma or certificate)
- Order additional copies of an awarded credential in English or French
- Receive notifications for important messages



Parent Signed myPass Credential Print Out


 Step 2: Click View Credential





Parent Signed myPass Credential Print Out


 Step 3: Check your list of remaining courses needed and verify with your PowerSchool list of courses registered, then download, and print the credential





Parent Signed myPass Credential Print Out


 Step 4: Parent signs on the printed credential page and student turns it into Student Services by October 20th


